



1 - ADMISSION CONDITIONS :

To enter into the camp-site, to be installed, to stay at the camp-site you have to have an authorization from the manager or his representative . He must ensure proper conduct and good order and make sure that visitors abide by these rules. Staying on the camp-site implies acceptance of these rules and regulations and commits you to comply.

2 - POLICE FORMALITIES :

All persons that stay for at least one night on the camp-site must beforehand show a passport or an identity card to the manager or his representative and fill in the formalities asked by the police. Persons under age not accompanied by their parents will not be admitted except with written consent of their parents.

3 - INSTALLATION :

The tent or caravan and equipment must be installed at the place indicated given by the manager or his representative.

4 - RECEPTION DESK :

Open from 9am. to 12 and from 4pm.to 6pm. (Out of season). Open from 8.30am to 1pm and 3pm to 7.30pm. (High season). You will find at the reception all information on camp-site services, information where to buy supplies, sports facilities, tourist sights in the area and divers addresses which could be useful to you. A reclamation book or a box is held at your disposition for this use. Reclamations will only be taken into consideration if they are signed and dated, with precisions and which tell of events relatively recent.

5 - PAYMENT DUE:

Rents are paid at the reception. The amount is shown at the entrance to the camp-site and also at the reception . The sum due is according to the number of nights spent at the camp-site. Campers are invited to inform the reception the day before their departure. Campers having the intention to leave before the opening of the reception desk must make their payment the day before their departure.

6 - NOISE AND SILENCE :

Campers are asked to avoid all noise and discussions that could hinder their neighbours. Sound appliances must be regulated so as to not annoy anyone. Closing of car doors and boots should be made as quietly as possible . Dogs and other animals must not be free to roam. They must not be left on the camp-site

(even shut in)during absence of the owner who is responsible for the animal and civilly liable. Total silence must be observed between 10pm.and 8 am.

7 - VISITORS :

After having been authorized by the manager or his representative, visitors can be admitted to the camp-site under the responsibility of the camper who receives the visit. The camper can receive one or more visitors at the reception . If his visitors are allowed into the site, the camper who receives the visit can be asked to pay a tarif (due to the fact that the visitor has access to prestations and installations on the camp-site). This charge is notified at the entrance to the camp-site and at the reception. Visitors cars are banned from entering.

8 - CIRCULATION AND PARKING :

Inside the camp-site the speed limit is limited to 10km per hour. Vehicules are banned from moving between 10pm and 8pm. Only vehicules belonging to campers staying on the site can circulate in the grounds. Parking is strictly banned on places normally occupied by shelters or awnings,vehicules mustn't hinder the circulation or prevent the installation of new arrivals.

9 - CONDUCT AND INSTALLATIONS :

Everyone is oblige to refrain from any action which might prejudice the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the camp-site. It is banned to throw dirty water on the ground or in the gutters. Caravan owners must empty their dirty water in the installations provided for this use. Household waste and waste of all nature, papers, must be deposited in the dustbins. Each person must refrain from all actions which might prejudice the cleanliness and hygiene of the camp-site and its installations, notably the sanitary installations. Washing is strictly banned except in the recipients meant for this use. Washing must be hung up in the communal drying area. However it is tolerated up to 10am. close to shelters or awnings under the condition that it is discreet and doesn't hinder the neighbours. It must never be hung from the trees. The plantations and flowers must be respected. It is banned to put nails in trees or cut branches or grow plants. It is not allowed either to personally define the limits of a space or to dig in the ground. All degradation committed to vegetation, to fences,ground or installations of the

campsite are at the charge of the person who has committed this offence. The space that was used during the stay must be kept in the condition in which the camper found it, when he entered into the camp-site.

10 - SECURITY :

a) Fire : Open fires (wood, charcoal, etc) are strictly banned. Gas camping appliances must be kept in good condition and not used in dangerous conditions. In case of fire the management must be immediately informed.If necessary fire extinguishers in working order are available. A first aid kit may be found at the reception.

b) Theft : The management is responsible for objects that are left at the office and has obligations to supervise the camping ground.The camper is responsible for his own installations and should warn the management of any suspicious person. The guarding of the camp-site is ensured, but campers are asked to take the usual precautions for the safeguard of their equipment.

11 - GAMES :

No violent game is allowed, or hindering, nor can games be organized close to the installations. The meeting room cannot be used for lively games. Children should always be under the supervision of their parents.

12 - UNOCCUPIED SPACE :

Unoccupied camping equipment mustn't be left except with the agreement of the management and in this case only on the space indicated.The amount due for the « garage mort » or unoccupied space will be shown at the office.

13 - BILLBOARD :

These rules and regulations are displayed at the entrance to the camp-site and at the reception desk. A copy of the rules is available on request.

14 - BREAKING OF THE RULES AND REGLEMENTATION OF THE CAMP-SITE :

In the case of a resident that disturbs other users or doesnt respect the rules of the campsite, the management or his representative can orally (or in writing if he judges necessary) warn this person to stop being a nuisance. In the case of a serious breach of the rules or repitition, and after a warning by the management to conform, the manager can break the contract. In the case of a criminal offence the manager may call the police.
